

Important Safety Information

What is the most important information I should know about PANCREAZE®? PANCREAZE® may increase your chance of having a serious, rare bowel disorder called fibrosing colonopathy that may require surgery. The risk of having this condition may be reduced by following the dosing instructions that your healthcare provider gave you.

Call your doctor right away if you have any unusual or severe stomach area (abdominal) pain, bloating, trouble passing stool (having bowel movements), nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.

Take PANCREAZE® exactly as prescribed by your doctor. Do not take more or less PANCREAZE® than directed by your doctor.

What should I tell my doctor before taking PANCREAZE®?

Tell your doctor if you:

- are allergic to pork (pig) products
- have a history of blockage of your intestines, or scarring or thickening of your bowel wall (fibrosing colonopathy)
- have gout, kidney disease, or high blood uric acid (hyperuricemia)
- have trouble swallowing capsules
- have any other medical condition
- are pregnant or plan to become pregnant
- are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed

Tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription and nonprescription medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

What are the possible side effects of PANCREAZE®?

PANCREAZE® may cause serious side effects, including:

- **A rare bowel disorder** called fibrosing colonopathy
- **Irritation of the inside of your mouth.** This can happen if PANCREAZE® is not swallowed completely
- **Increase in blood uric acid levels.** This may cause worsening of swollen, painful joints (gout) caused by an increase in your blood uric acid levels
- **Allergic reactions** including trouble with breathing, skin rashes, or swollen lips

Call your doctor right away if you have any of these symptoms.

The most common side effects include pain in your stomach (abdominal pain) and gas.

Other possible side effects: PANCREAZE® and other pancreatic enzyme products are made from the pancreas of pigs, the same pigs people eat as pork. These pigs may carry viruses. Although it has never been reported, it may be possible for a person to get a viral infection from taking pancreatic enzyme products that come from pigs.

Getting started with PANCREAZE®

Your doctor has prescribed PANCREAZE® because you or your child has a condition called **Exocrine Pancreatic Insufficiency**, or EPI.

What is EPI?

EPI is a medical term for a condition that occurs when the pancreas doesn't produce enough digestive enzymes. Fortunately, these enzymes can be replaced using Pancreatic Enzyme Replacement Therapy.



Normally, the pancreas releases a mixture of enzymes (called *lipases*, *proteases* and *amylases*) to digest the fats, proteins and carbohydrates in food. In patients with EPI, the pancreas does not make enough enzymes to digest food. Without enough enzymes, patients with EPI **do not digest food properly or get the nutrition** they need. This can lead to:

- Poor weight gain (especially important in infants/toddlers)
- Frequent, loose and/or large bowel movements
- Foul-smelling bowel movements
- Mucus or oil in bowel movements
- Excessive gas and/or abdominal pain
- Bloating

What is Pancreatic Enzyme Replacement Therapy (PERT)?

PERT replaces the digestive enzymes that you or your child need. **PANCREAZE® is a type of PERT.**

What is PANCREAZE®?

PANCREAZE® is a prescription medicine used to treat people who cannot digest food normally because their pancreas does not make enough enzymes. It contains a mixture of digestive enzymes, including lipases, proteases, and amylases, to help the body digest fats, proteins, and carbohydrates from food.

PANCREAZE® is safe and effective in adults and children when taken as prescribed by your doctor.

How does PANCREAZE® help?

By replacing enzymes, the pancreas is unable to produce, PANCREAZE® helps you or your child **digest food properly and absorb the fat, protein and carbohydrates** needed for healthy growth, weight gain and improved nutritional health. PANCREAZE® has been studied in several clinical trials and used for **over 30 years** around the world.

Are there possible side effects?

The most common side effects of PANCREAZE® are abdominal pain and gas. Other side effects are possible:

- Irritation of the inside of your mouth
- Increase in blood uric acid levels
- Allergic reactions

Call your doctor right away if you have any of these symptoms

How do I take/administer PANCREAZE®?

Keep these “Do’s and Don’ts” on hand to help ensure you take or administer PANCREAZE® properly. Always follow your healthcare professional’s advice.

✓ DO'S	✗ DON'TS
DO take/administer PANCREAZE® exactly as your doctor tells you. Your doctor may change the dose based on the amount of fatty foods eaten or your weight.	DO NOT take/administer more capsules in a day than the number your doctor tells you (total daily dose).
DO store PANCREAZE® at room temperature below 77°F (25°C).	DO NOT store PANCREAZE® near heat.
For children over 12 months and adults:	
DO take PANCREAZE® with a meal or snack and plenty of fluid. If you eat a lot of meals or snacks in a day, be careful not to go over your total daily dose.	DO NOT crush or chew the capsules or their contents or hold the capsule or contents in your mouth. Crushing, chewing or holding the PANCREAZE® capsules in your mouth may cause irritation in your mouth or change the way PANCREAZE® works in your body.
For caregivers of infants (children up to 12 months):	
DO administer right before each feeding of formula or breast milk.	DO NOT mix directly with formula or breastmilk.

If you or your child is unable to swallow the capsules, you can sprinkle the contents on soft acidic food (e.g., applesauce, orange juice; crushed blueberries). Drink water or juice immediately after to ensure the medicine is swallowed completely.



Having an open dialogue with your healthcare team is key to making the most out of treatment. Ask any questions you have, and ensure you get the answers you need.
